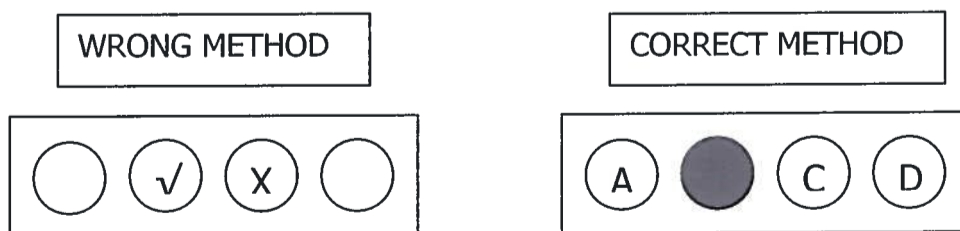


IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS TO THE CANDIDATES

(Candidates are advised to follow carefully the instructions given below. Failure to follow the instructions will result in invalidation of your OMR Answer Sheet)

1. Candidates are advised **to reach** their respective Examination Centres **one hour before the commencement of the examination i.e. 9.00 a.m., as the Screening Test will be conducted from 10.00 a.m. to 12.00 noon.**
2. Candidates will be permitted to enter into the Examination Hall/Room from 9.30 a.m. No candidate will be permitted **to enter into the Examination Hall after 10.15 a.m. or leave the Examination Hall before 10.30 a.m.**
3. **Candidates shall bring along with them two(2) Blue or Black Ball Point Pens.** They will not be supplied in the Examination Hall.
4. **Candidates have to use Blue or Black Ball Point pen only for filling the details in the OMR sheet and also to fill/darken the appropriate circle fully while answering in the OMR sheet.**
5. **Using of Gel Pens/Pencils and also using the Whitener/Blade/Eraser or any kind of tampering to change the answers on OMR answer sheet will lead to invalidation of the OMR answer sheet.**
6. **Change of OMR answer sheet is not permitted under any circumstances.**
7. Candidates shall produce their Hall Ticket at the Entrance of the Examination Centre and also in the Examination Hall/Room, failing which the candidates will not be allowed to write the examination. The candidates shall sign the attendance sheet in the Examination Hall.
8. OMR Answer Sheet will not be valued if the candidate writes any irrelevant matter, symbols, religious marks or identification marks on any part of OMR Answer Sheet or the Question paper Booklet as it amounts to malpractice. Any mark, other than the information needed to be entered on the OMR sheet will be treated as a malpractice.
9. Candidates have to **write their Hall Ticket No. on the Question Paper provided to them also.**
10. The question paper shall consist of 100 questions to be answered in two hours duration.
11. The examination is based on objective type with multiple choice of answers.
12. Fill one character/digit per box and darken the appropriate circle fully using ball point pen (Blue/Black). For each question 4 circles are provided with four options A,B,C,D. Mark your answer by darkening the appropriate circle fully.

Your answer will be treated as wrong if you darken more than one circle for any question. Hence, before darkening a circle in OMR Sheet, confirm yourself about the correctness of the answer. No extra OMR Sheet will be provided under any circumstances, if any mistake is made while entering the hall ticket number or answers in the OMR Sheet provided to the candidate.

13. Candidates should not indulge in speaking with others or disturbing others in the Examination Hall.
14. DO NOT fold, tear, wrinkle, tie or staple the OMR Answer Sheet. DO NOT do any rough work or make any stray marks on the OMR Answer Sheet.
15. Candidates have to **return the OMR answer sheet to the Invigilator after answering the Questions within the stipulated time.**
16. Candidates are **permitted to take the Question paper**, instead of returning the same to the Invigilator.
17. Carrying of Cell Phones, Books, Bags and Loose Sheets of paper into the Examination Hall is strictly prohibited. They shall be kept outside the Examination Hall at their own risk.
18. Screening Test will cover the following subjects, as already mentioned in the Recruitment Notification dated 16.8.2016.

a) Substantive Laws comprising of:

Indian Contract Act, Hindu Marriage Act, Hindu Succession Act, Easements Act, Specific Relief Act, Limitation Act, Transfer of Property Act, Indian Penal Code, Negotiable Instruments Act, Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, Registration Act, Indian Stamp Act, A.P. Land Encroachment Act, Andhra Pradesh Buildings (Lease, Rent and Eviction) Control Act and

b) Procedural Laws comprising of:

Civil Procedure Code, Criminal Procedure Code, Evidence Act, Civil Rules of Practice and Criminal Rules of Practice.

19. OMR Answer sheets are scanned by a scanning machine. The machine scans the sheet and only picks up the filled circles, but not the matter written in boxes. Correct filling of circles is of utmost importance.
